This version of AutoCAD added a full graphical user interface (GUI) and other desktop-style features. In 1998, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2000 for Windows, a commercial version of the AutoCAD GUI. On May 30, 2011, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2014, a major upgrade to AutoCAD. The upgrade's first major addition was tag-based styling. This feature allows users to place dimensions and dimension tags and scale them to any size. In addition, AutoCAD introduced direct editing of more complex 2D objects such as text frames, multilevel baselines, and table frames. In July 2012, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2015, the first major revision of AutoCAD since 2005. This release adds the ability to create a picture or camera view to a 2D drawing. In addition, it adds a new perspective view that allows you to see the drawing from any angle, such as from above or below. On April 3, 2013, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2016, the second major revision of AutoCAD since 2009. The 2016 release includes

They decided to develop a Windows-based CAD system that would operate on a PC and could be accessed by the home office. In 1979, the name "AutoCAD" was given to the system and it was distributed to customers in the spring of 1980. By the early 1980s, the number of companies and individuals who used CAD technology was growing rapidly and Autodesk recognized a need for a simple and powerful CADD system to meet the demands of these users. Autodesk was considering other possibilities, including developing a CAD system for use on an Apple II computer. John Walker, the creator of AutoCAD, was given the opportunity to build a system that would run on a PC. At the time, PCs were considered expensive, incompatible and running an incompatible operating system. A great deal of research and development were required to make this happen. However, one of the major changes, replacing the open architecture of AutoCAD and MIT System II, was to use an object-oriented

programming model. The initial version of AutoCAD, known as AutoCAD 2.0 was released on December 6, 1980, and sold ca3bfb1094
